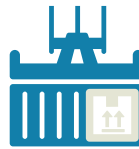


SEA FREIGHT LCL CLEARANCES EXPLAINED



You purchase your goods overseas
Your goods are placed inside a container with other goods



The container is placed onboard a ship to bring your goods to Australia



If the goods are made from wood they need to be fumigated prior to shipping



Melbourne Customs Broker need 7 things to proceed (email to info@customs.melbourne)



1 A commercial invoice for the goods



2 Bill of Lading



3 Packing List



4 Packing Declaration ([download here](#))



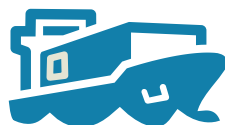
5 Photos of the goods



6 Authorisation form ([download here](#))



7 Fumigation Certificate (if applicable)



While the goods travel to Australia, we will be busy pre-clearing the cargo through customs and quarantine



Once the goods arrive the container is taken to a depot for unpacking and separating.



Once they are unpacked you have 3 days to collect (or we can have your goods delivered to you)



SCENARIO 1
Customs and DAFF (Department of Agriculture Fisheries and Forestry) release the goods.



You collect goods from the depot OR we can deliver them to you



SCENARIO 2
DAFF (Department of Agriculture Fisheries and Forestry) wish to inspect the goods



DAFF release the goods



You collect goods from Quarantine depot OR we can deliver them to you
